Andalusia is an autonomous comunity in the south of Spain and it has 87,268 square kilometers, it is the second largest autonomous comunity after Castilia-Lenón. It has **8 provinces**: Huelva, Sevilla, Córdoba, Jaén, Cádiz, Málaga, Granada and Almería.





The capital city is **Seville** with 141 square kilometers and population around 683,000 people (the 4th biggest city in Spain). It was first mentioned in 9th century BC. It played a big role when the Maures

were defending themselves on the Iberian Peninsula because it was a strong fortress. In 1248, after a long siege, Seville was conquered by the Christian King Ferdinand III of Castile, and he made it one of the capitals of his kingdom. Since then it became Christian.

As Czechia has Krkonoše, Andalusia has **Sierra Nevada** with the highest mountain - **Mulhacén** (3,478 meters above sea level) and it's the highest mountain of the Iberian Peninsula and the **Genil River** starts its journey in Sierra Nevada. It drains in the Guadalquivir River.

The **Guadalquivir River** is the longest river in Andalusia (657 kilometres) and the fifth longest in Spain. **The Guadiana River** is a river partly in Portugal but mostly in Spain, it's 100 kilometres long on the border between Spain and Portugal.
