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The school which we visited is situated in **a village Enguera**, about 1 hour from **the city of Valencia in Spain**. The school has about **350 pupils** combining pre-school education and primary school education. Enguera has about 5,000 inhabitants. Children go to this school from the **age of 6 – 12**, it means for **6 grades** and from 3-6 to the pre-school education.



The timetable is different from the Czech timetable. **School starts at 9 o'clock** and the lessons continue **till 11 o'clock**. At 11 a.m., the children have a break which starts with a snack in the classroom and then after 15 minutes they go to the school playground for 30 minutes. They play games, sports or just relax outside. At 11.45 all pupils go back to classrooms, open a book and **read quietly for 15 minutes their own books or books borrowed from the library**. At 12 o'clock, they continue classes which finish at 1.30 p.m.

The school has **a school canteen** which cooks lunches both for the pre-school pupils and the school pupils. There are only 2 ladies who cook all the meals.

Children can go home **at 2 o'clock p.m.** if their parents collect them or stay at school till **3.30 p.m.** when they go home.

The number of pupils in the classes is lower about 15-18. They all learn English as a foreign language. Gym is in a separated building in the middle of the playground.

All the school is nicely decorated. In the past they kept animals in the school yard in the cages – peacock, pig and hens but now it is



prohibited now. There is a public open swimming pool near the school which they can use for swimming classes in the summer.
