MY SPANISH HOST FAMILY

There were four people in the family: **mum (Cris), dad (Gabi), sister (Carla) and my Spanish host (Mar)**. We stayed in Enguera which was 1 hour from Valencia. They had two cars, they looked similar, both looked like a white van.

The best English speaker in the family was the father because he works as **a guide in the museum**. They live in **a flat**.

Their house was small but cozy, it had two floors, but someone else lived on the second floor. Their house had a door, but **in front of the door there was a wooden curtain – typical for Enguera**.

They had another house near the mountains with a swimming pool and even animals like **donkeys, sheep, dogs, cats**, etc. but I wasn't there.

Their family was quite healthy, so they only had junk food once a week. After breakfast, lunch and dinner they always had **an orange or a banana**. Their oranges were very sweet, which is why oranges are often imported from Spain.

They went to bed at around midnight so I talked to them until eleven about how I liked it here and what food I wanted for the next day which was great. They **had dinner quite late**, which I didn't expect and **I had to get used to it**. They made us **churros** once, they were good but they were quite oily and sometimes **they dipped the strawberries in sugar**, it was really good. I always had a sandwich and water for my school snack.

After every dinner **we went for a walk which was relaxing**. I liked that I had my own room and privacy. Sometimes they would leave us out until 11 pm when we went out with the others. We even played doorbell game with Cris (Mar's mom) and with others.

I was surprised that Enguera is quite big and that **everyone knows each other** there, which I thought was nice. Because Mar was greeting everyone we met.



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
