

REPORT FROM 2nd PROJECT MEETING IN BOSA, SARDINIA, ITALY SUNDAY 20th AND MONDAY 21th MARCH 2022

Sunday 20th March 2022



On Sunday we left very early in the morning for **the airport in Vienna**. We all said goodbye to our families and in a group of 5 students and 2 adults we drove in a microbus to the airport. We were all very tired because we got up really early so we all kind of slept

in the car. When we got to the airport we went to check in our luggage and drink all the water because they wouldn't let us through security. Then we got our plane tickets. We flew from Vienna to Milan, Italy and from there we flew to our final location, which **was Alghero, Sardinia**. After arrival we were waiting for a while for the Spanish and then we took a bus to **Bosa** together (a town **in Sardinia**). The journey there seemed very long because everyone was very nervous about meeting the host families and we were afraid that they would not speak English which was confirmed later. We arrived at the place and it was in front of the school where the families were waiting for us. My hosting girl took my suitcase and put it in her mom's



car and told me that we were going to see the city, but we took Klára and her hosting girl with us because the Italian girls were very good friends. We walked around for a while and we saw the boys walking through the city too and we also found out that **all the Czech hosts know each other and are friends** so we practically spent all our free time together. Since we were staying completely out of town on a mountain, we were almost always the first to leave. Martina's dad picked us up in the car and we went home. They lived in a big house where with the whole family. It was kind of yellow on the outside. Inside there was no heating but there was a fireplace which was much more pleasant than a heater. I went to unpack my suitcase and get settled in and Martina called me for dinner, we **had**



pasta with sauce and since they have a multi-course dinner we had croquettes with ketchup and then salad with meat. It was very good but it was too much so I was overeaten. Then she showed me where my room was and I went

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straight to the bathroom because I needed a shower after about 6 hours. I really wanted to go to sleep but Martina told me that they go to bed at 1-2 in the morning, however I went to bed at 11 p.m.

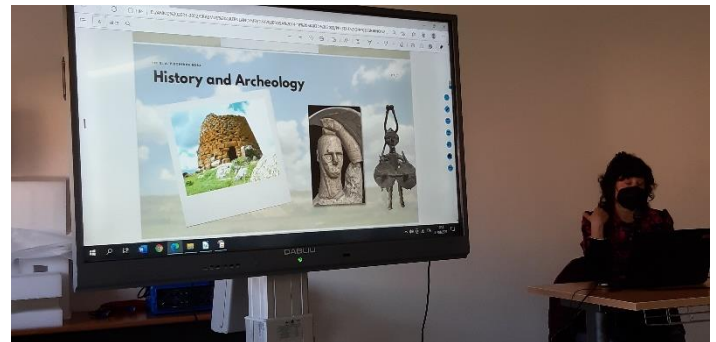
Monday 21th March 2022
