The next day, on Tuesday morning we took a long journey to our partner school we had programme school at where we were welcomed bv the headmistress and the children playing

**flutes.** Then there was a tour of the school. The school was similar in size to ours but the classrooms were different - they were much smaller than in the Czech Republic. Just about 15 children could fit in one classroom.

We took a bus to the monastery which is the main means of transport used together with trolleybuses in Kaunas. As soon as we arrived, the guide was waiting for us



and we went to the small museum which was built next to the monastery first. The guide was speaking in English. In the museum we learned many things about the lives of the monks who lived in the

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monastery, what all it took to be a monk and what they had to give up. We visited the main building; the church and we also saw the garden outside.

After the tour of the monastery, on our way back we visited the beach of one of the lakes where the wind



was blowing hard so we hurried as fast as we could to the warm restaurant of Evlada where the dinner was waiting for us. We has a typical Lithuanian meal.

When we finished the whole day we were tired and full, so all teams got on the bus and we went back to the different hotels in the city centre where we were staying.



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
