REPORT FROM 6th PROJECT MEETING IN QUIMPER, FRANCE TUESDAY 21st JUNE 2022



I woke up around 6:30 a.m. on Tuesday. I got dressed, made my bed, etc. Around 7 a.m., my host family called me for breakfast. They asked how I was, how I slept, and what we were going to do today. I had cereal
