My Spanish host family

His mother usually drove us to the programs and his dad often drove us too, and in the car I discovered that they like to listen to loud music, so there was always a nice atmosphere in the car.

We usually went somewhere with other Czech and Spanish friends and on Saturday we had our own program just me and my family plus another couple of friends from Erasmus and their parents. Once we even went to the dentist with Mauricio and from there we went to a program with our other friends.

Overall, his family had a very positive attitude and they were very pleasant, so I enjoyed my time with them.

Saturday 7th February with my host family

In the morning I slept until about 10 o'clock because I was woken up by their crazy dog which wanted to play as always, but despite that I slept well. For breakfast I had cereal with milk as always.

Immediately after that we set off on an hour-long car journey filled with music.
