Friday 17 October 2025

I was really looking forward for this workshop. **There we were split into several groups of 5 people, then Nela and the lady who works here in Chocolate Museum showed us step by step how to make our own chocolate.** I took some marshmallows and other sweet things that I could put on my chocolate in the cup, then we started by taking a bag of chocolate and weighing it, then making a pouring hole in it, pouring it into the mould and smoothing it out. Then we put the sweets on it and let it sit a bit to get cold. Then after we finished the chocolate, the Czech team took a picture together and said goodbye to the Swedes and the French who were leaving that day and went to a small souvenir shop right in the chocolate museum.



I really enjoyed this workshop, for me it was the best workshop of the week. It was very fun and it felt good to learn. Then, when we picked up our bags from the lockers we were ready to leave.

We walked towards one pizza restaurant that was near our hotel. When we arrived at the pizza we took a seat and the waiter gave us a menu. Me and my roommate Tadeáš picked up the ham pizza, the place was good and little bit old style, after a few minutes we got our pizza, pizza was good and when we ate it, we said good-bye and we went to our hotel which was one minute from the pizza place, when we arrived we were still tired from yesterday because yesterday was a party and we arrived at midnight, so teachers gave us a long time to rest.
