Saturday 18 October 2025

It was the last day of our Erasmus trip. Almost everyone left, so we didn't have any activity with other teams. Because our departure was at ten o'clock in the evening, we decided to go to the Zoo and go to the city to buy souvenirs for our parents and friends.
